The Mozambique Program for Conservation Leadership (PLCM), implemented by the Foundation for the Conservation of Biodiversity (BIOFUND), is a USD 2.4 M program funded by the World Bank for a period of 5 years (2019-2023) through the MozBio II Project. The program is a unique opportunity in the country to strengthen the capacity and skills of professionals in the National System of Conservation Areas (SNAC) and shape the profile of future conservation leaders in Mozambique
