Focused on cooperation, training and education, the António Coutinho Research Scholarships reinforce the stimulus to diversity in the scientific community by promoting students, professors and scientists to boost their careers in the areas of life sciences, health sciences or exact sciences.

The António Coutinho Research Scholarships are awarded to citizens of the PALOP (African countries with Portuguese as an official language) and their descendants.

Who can apply?

- 1. Undergraduate or master's students, citizens of and residents in one of the *PALOP*. This scholarship allows the pursuit of an experimental research internship in a Portuguese research institution as part of an undergraduate or master thesis work;
- 2. Master's students, citizens of one of the PALOP, or afro-descendants, living in Portugal. This scholarship allows an experimental research internship to be carried out at a research institution located in the municipality of Oeiras as part of a master's thesis work. Students residing in Oeiras will have the option to choose a research institution anywhere in the country;
- 3. *Professors or researchers living in one of the PALOP.* This scholarship allows the development of advanced research work at a Portuguese research institution.
