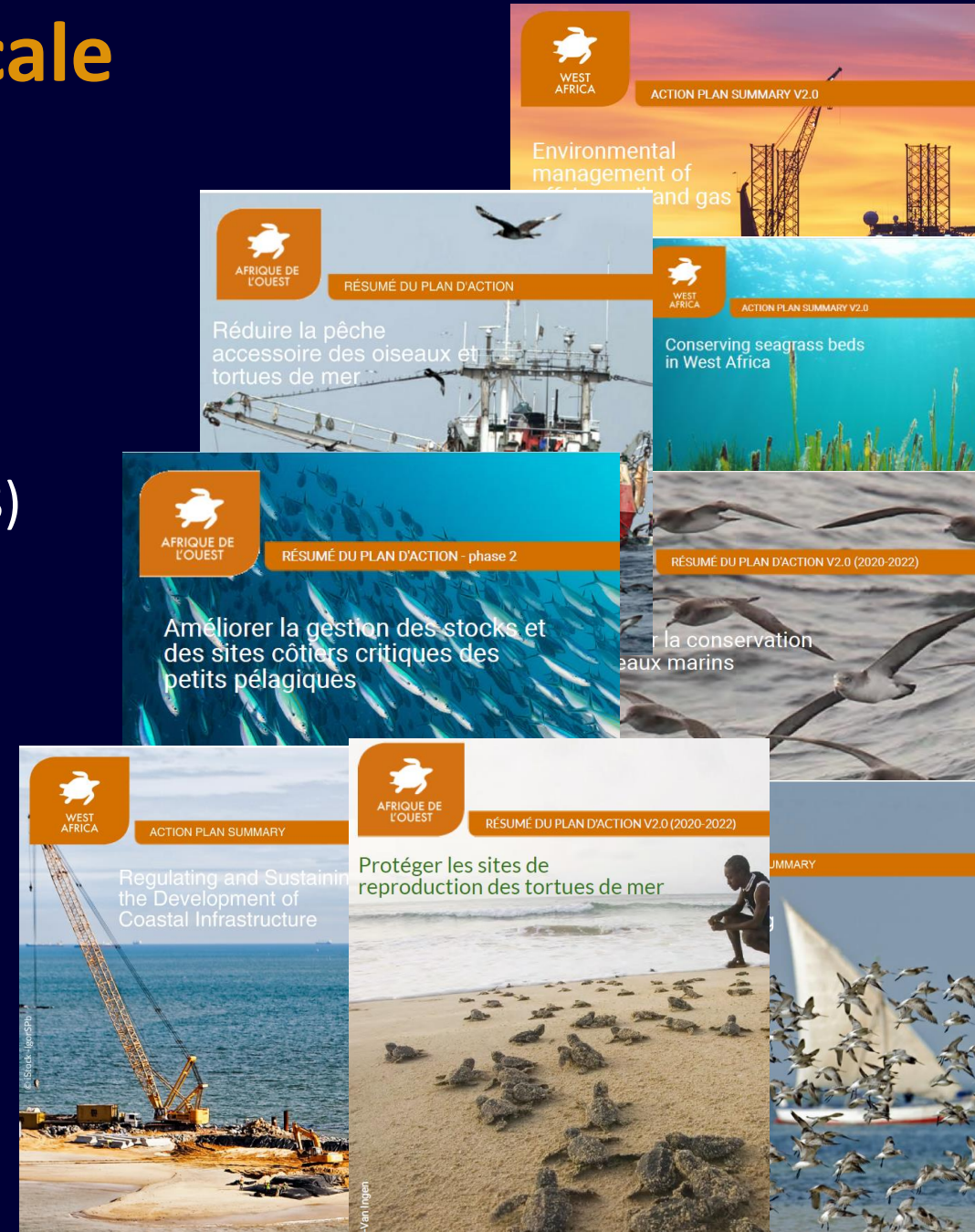

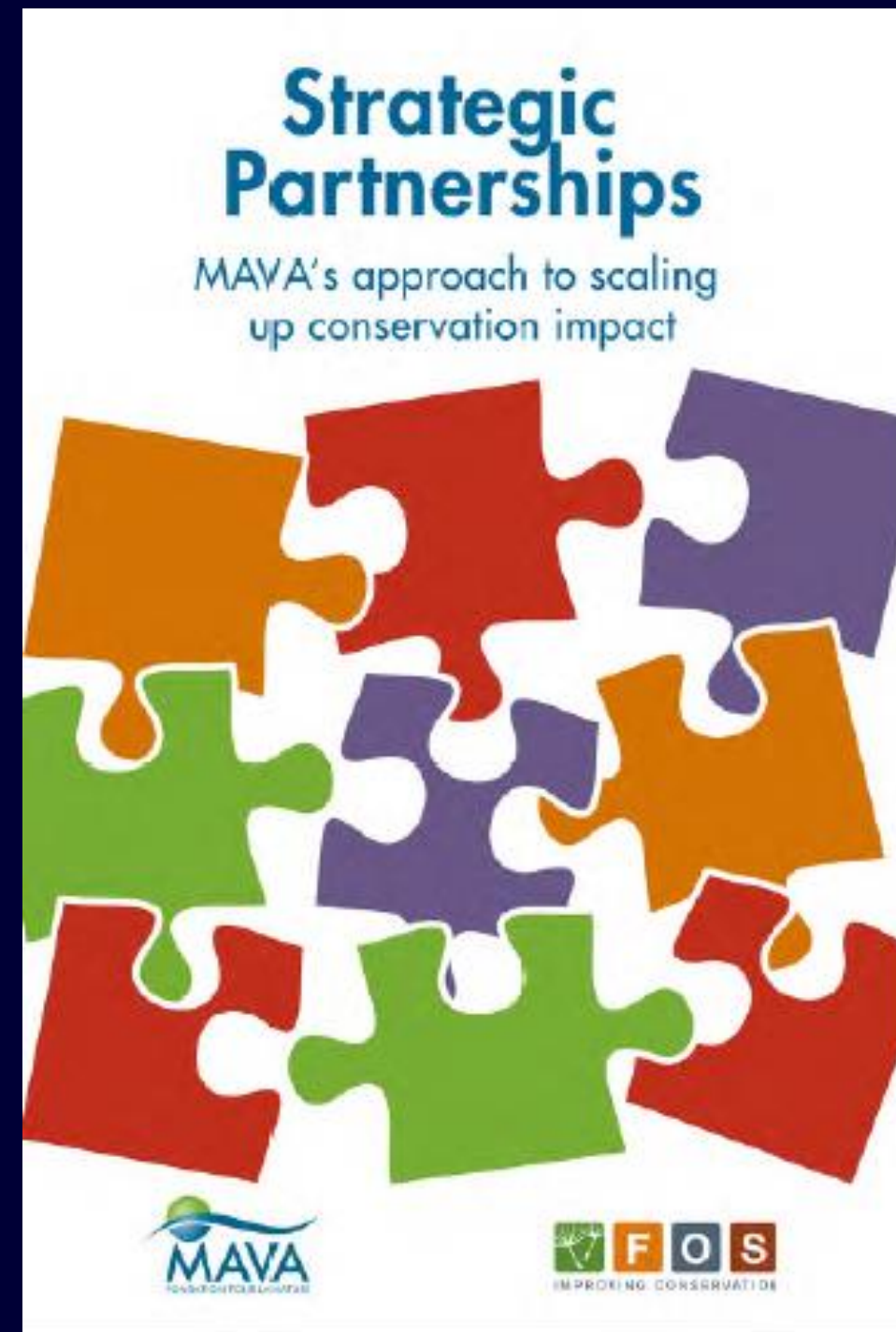

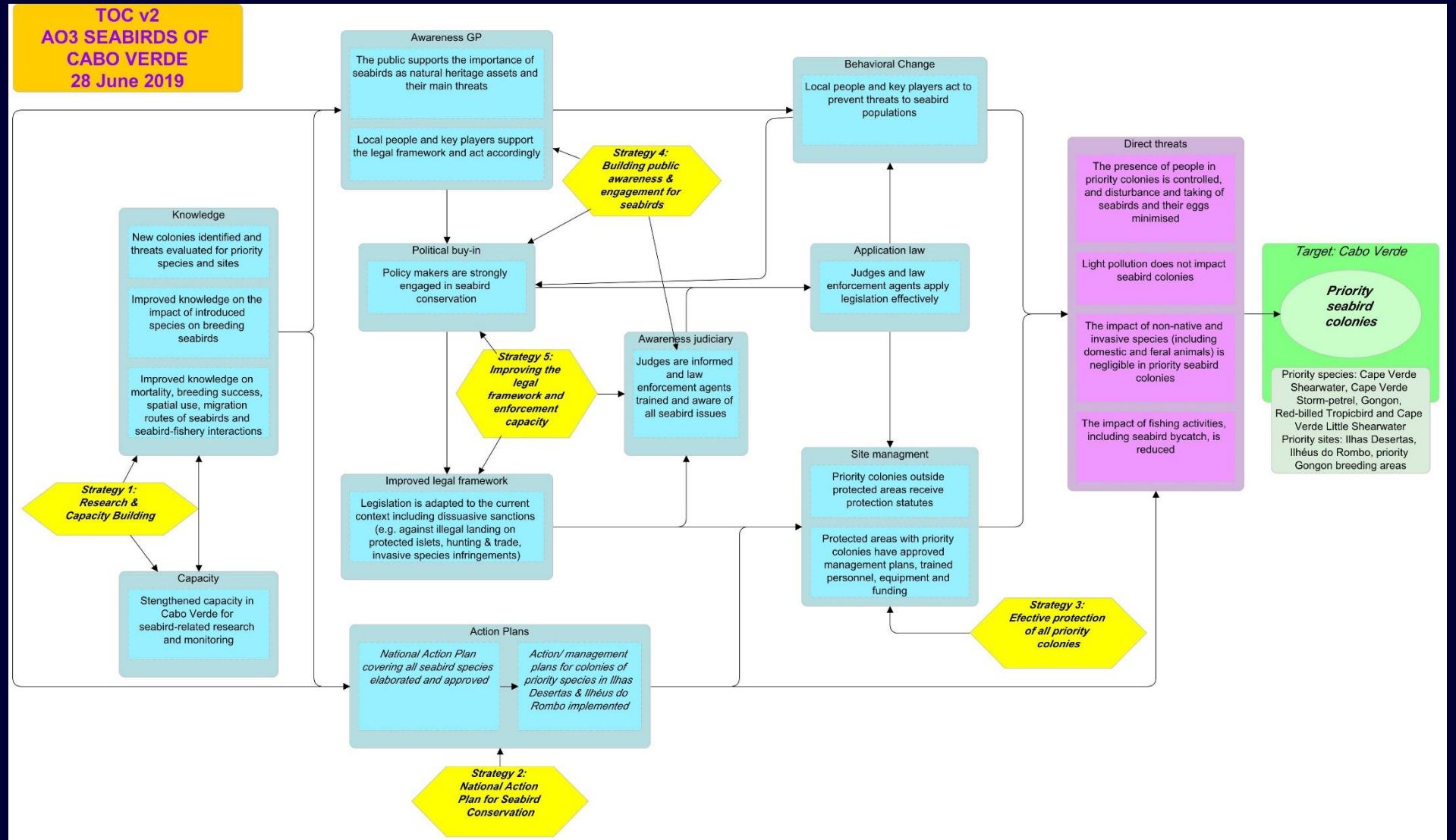
Map of Cabo Verde showing protected areas in green (map: DNA)

Asking the right questions – Beyond activities implementation

1. Are we doing the right things?
And are we implementing them well enough, on the right scale, with the right intensity?
2. Are we having an impact? Are we seeing changes ?
3. What else do we need to do, or what do we need to do differently to have more impact?

Engaging beyond individual projects/sites

Overarching costs including operations; M&E implementation; impact assessment; long-term visibility...



Lessons learnt



- Define shared vision, defined partnership scope and composition
 - Clear, ambitious yet realistic goals
- Implement conservation actions that are relevant at scale
 - Look beyond individual projects/sites
- Shift from action-oriented towards impact-oriented approaches
 - Well designed and useful monitoring and evaluation system
- Shared responsibility for M&E
 - Agreed mechanism for scaling up impact.
